## An Overview

Serving a community of nearly one million people, the Citrus Valley Health Partners mission is lived through the work of our 3,000+ staff members, more than 1,000 physicians and four outstanding health care facilities.

■ Citrus Valley Medical Center – **Queen of the Valley Campus** is renowned for its family-centered maternity services and Level IIIB Newborn Intensive Care Unit (NICU). This campus also offers robotic surgery and a full range of rehabilitation services, including speech, occupational and physical therapy for children and adults.

■ Citrus Valley Medical Center – **Inter-Community Campus** offers a complete range of inpatient and outpatient services, specializing in cancer treatment, wound care, electrophysiology and cardiac care, with the only open heart surgery program in the East San Gabriel Valley.

■ **Foothill Presbyterian Hospital** offers a unique blend of general acute care and specialty services, including the Citrus Valley Centers for Rehabilitation Services and an Outpatient Diabetes Education Program recognized by the American Diabetes Association as a Center of Excellence for diabetes education.

■ **Citrus Valley Hospice** has an extensive home care program as well as a 10-bed inpatient facility recognized as the first freestanding hospice of its kind in California.

■ Associated with Hospice, **Citrus Valley Home Health** provides physician-supervised nursing and rehabilitation care to individuals recovering at home from accidents, surgery or illness.

## A Closer Look



**Citrus Valley Medical Center – Queen of the Valley Campus**

Founded in 1962 by the Immaculate Heart Community, the 325-bed Citrus Valley Medical Center – Queen of the Valley Campus is a fully accredited nonprofit, Catholic health care facility in West Covina.

### Key Services:

- **Family-centered Maternity Services** – More deliveries are made at this campus than any health care facility in the East San Gabriel Valley. And its Level IIIB NICU has cared for more than 15,000 babies since its opening in 1972.
- **The Geleris Family Cancer Center** – Offering complete education, diagnosis, treatment and support services. Patients are kept apprised of ongoing clinical cancer trials and can participate, when eligible.
- **Mammography Center** – Providing low-cost mammography screening and breast health education.

- **Robotic Surgery Program featuring the da Vinci Si Surgical System**
- **12-bed Rehabilitation Unit**
- **State-of-the-art MRI, CAT scan and Lithotripsy Services**
- **18-bed Pediatric Unit**
- **Citrus Valley Centers for Rehabilitation Services** – Offering speech, occupational and physical therapy services for children and adults.

**Citrus Valley Medical Center – Inter-Community Campus**



Citrus Valley Medical Center – Inter-Community Campus was founded more than 80 years ago. The nonprofit 222-bed facility in Covina provides high-quality health care to the East San Gabriel Valley, with a wide range of medical, surgical and specialty services.

- **Citrus Valley Heart Center** – Offering electrophysiology (mapping of the heart) and the only open heart surgery program in the East San Gabriel Valley.

### Citrus Valley Hospice



Citrus Valley Hospice was founded in 1979. Hospice has an extensive home care program, as well as 10 inpatient beds when acute care is required. Hospice helps families through end of life transitions in a supportive, life-affirming environment. Bereavement and spiritual counseling, along with grief support groups, are also offered to family members.

### Additional Programs

- **Citrus Valley Home Health** – Provides physician-supervised assistance to patients and their families requiring home health aid, infusion therapy, private duty nursing, wound care, rehabilitation therapy and other types of therapy.

Affiliated with Citrus Valley Hospice, hospice care can be provided in the home as well as the inpatient facility.

### The Citrus Valley Medical Center Family Birth & Newborn Center



Standing at approximately 100,000 square feet, The Family Birth & Newborn Center at the Queen of the Valley Campus combines state-of-the-art technologies with an integrated, family-centered approach to maternal, neonatal and pediatric care.

Services include the full continuum of health and wellness care, pre- and post-delivery education and support groups, and access to the most current treatments, provided in an environment that encourages family support and involvement.

## Citrus Valley Health Partners Community Outreach

While Citrus Valley Health Partners (CVHP) is focused on healing the sick, we are also dedicated to reaching out to those who may never walk through our doors. The young woman with a family history of breast cancer who wants to learn about early detection. Parents whose child was just diagnosed with juvenile diabetes. The older man who unexpectedly loses his life's mate and doesn't know where to turn. On average, our Community Wellness Services department offers more than 50 different programs, services and support groups each month – curriculum covering a variety of health and wellness topics for the entire family.

CVHP is an organization recognized for our outstanding community outreach efforts and accomplishments. An organization dedicated to creating innovative partnerships among the numerous health and social

service organizations in our valley, with close to 100 agencies forming a collaborative relationship devoted to promoting community health and well-being.

For example, our **Partnership Nursing Program** is based on the concept that through working partnerships between faith communities, community organizations and medical professionals, health and wellness issues can be significantly improved. **Every Child's Healthy Option (ECHO)** is a collaborative effort involving CVHP, local school districts and health providers that ensures that every child, regardless of income level, has access to quality health care. **Promoters of Health** is a peer education program designed to teach and inspire at-risk children – ages 12 to 20 – to make healthy decisions. And through the **Get Enrollment Moving** program, also known as GEM, volunteers and CVHP staff members work together to recruit eligible families and enroll them in Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or other state programs. Families must meet certain criteria to qualify

and cost varies depending on income, number of children and other factors. The program is funded by state and county grants awarded to CVHP.

For our accomplishments and outstanding efforts to improve the community's health and well-being, we were named winner of a **1999 VHA Leadership Award** in Community Health Improvement. CVHP was one of only eight honorees nationwide to receive a Voluntary Hospitals of America, Inc. (VHA) award in 1999 and was the only California-based organization to be recognized.

As a team of the four finest health care institutions in the region, our collective strengths enable us to continue the commitment to excellence the San Gabriel Valley has come to know and trust.
